

ALASKA GENERAL ELECTION TIMELINE



OCTOBER 9

DEADLINE TO REGISTER TO VOTE
Make sure that you are registered to vote at your current voting address by October 9th! You can update your voting address online, mail in a form or visit a voter registration agency in your area.

OCTOBER 29

THE LAST DAY TO REQUEST A MAIL IN BALLOT

If you plan to vote by mail, make sure you've requested your absentee ballot by October 29th! You can apply for a mail-in-ballot online, or by mailing your application to the Division of Elections.



OCTOBER 29

EARLY VOTING STARTS
Early voting starts in many communities on October 29th. You can vote early at any regional election office statewide.

NOVEMBER 8TH

ELECTION DAY!

On Election Day you can vote at any early vote location or at your polling place. If you plan to vote by mail, make sure that your mail in ballot is postmarked or handed off to an election official on or before Election Day. Don't forget to get a witness signature on your mail in ballot!
